Dear Secretary Foxx, Secretary Kerry and Secretary Pritzker:

We are writing to express our strong support for America's Open Skies policy and our strong opposition to freezing new routes or flights by the Gulf carriers, Emirates, Etihad Airways and Qatar Airways. Such a move would effectively breach U.S. Open Skies agreements with the United Arab Emirates and Qatar.

The U.S. has negotiated more than 100 Open Skies agreements with friendly governments around the world, creating a highly competitive international travel market that delivers greater consumer choice and lower airfares for passengers. Many U.S. cities and destinations that were once largely shut out of the international travel market now enjoy new access to international travelers because of Open Skies.

As you know, expanding international travel is a key component of the U.S. travel industry's growth strategy over the coming decades. Millions of potential travelers from the rising middle class in India, Asia and the Middle East represent the market of the future for hundreds of American cities and destinations, thousands of American business that depend on travel and millions of American jobs supported by travel spending. These are precisely the markets well served by the Gulf carriers and underserved by U.S. legacy carriers.

In considering the U.S. legacy carriers' request, we hope you will take the interests of the <u>entire</u> U.S. travel industry into account and protect U.S. Open Skies agreements. Preserving U.S. Open Skies

agreements is critical to reaching the Obama Administration's goal of attracting 100 million international visitors per year by 2021 – a goal we wholeheartedly endorse and are committed to achieving.
